ASAP Incentives for State Councils and College Councils

State "Pass the Hat"

Every state council is encouraged to "pass the hat," especially during their state conventions, to raise money for pregnancy resource centers and maternity homes as part of the Order's ASAP program. To reward those who do this most effectively, the jurisdiction in each membership division (1-6) that raises the most money by May 31 will receive a check for \$1500. Funds donated to PRCs and MHs will also be matched 25% with a cap of \$12,500 per jurisdiction. Help the Order reach its \$5 million end-of-year goal for ASAP and earn extra funds for women in need and your jurisdiction!

College Councils

The top ten college councils who raise the most funds for pregnancy resource centers and maternity homes by the end of the fraternal year will be awarded the following funds for their general fund:

- 1st (\$1,500)
- 2nd and 3rd (\$1,000)
- 4th and 5th (\$750)
- 6th-10th (\$500)

Funds donated to PRCs and MHs will also be matched 25% with a cap of \$12,500 per council. College Councils can also work with local councils to carry out their fundraisers – so reach out to a nearby college council to help!

Pregnancy and Parenting Support (PREPARES) is a statewide initiative of the Catholic Bishops of Washington State.

It provides pregnancy and parenting support services through Catholic parishes across Washington State, serving all families from pregnancy to their child's fifth birthday. All are welcome to participate in the free support that PREPARES provides.

PREPARES supports the commitment to the sanctity of human life, especially in its most vulnerable early stages. It seeks not only to assure healthy births and avoid the tragedy of abortion, but also to provide emotional support to nurture healthy and flourishing relationships that uphold the vision of the family as the essential unit of society.

Thus, I encourage Councils to begin whatever kind of fundraising drive makes sense in their area or parish to raise money for the *Pass the Hat* at the Convention. During the Saturday Afternoon Business Session, we will *Pass the Hat* (envelopes) at the tables to collect donations from councils and individuals.
