Brothers and other Seahawk Volunteers,
The Seahawks schedule is out for the 2026/2027 Football Season and St. Theresa Council 7908 is planning to work the concessions again this year.

As you know, this is the most significant fund raiser for our council and as in previous years we can use all the help we can get to make this season a success.

No food or alcohol server experience is necessary and as always we can use new faces in the booth. The more people that we have available, the easier it will be to staff the games. The schedule (below) includes a number of weekday and Sunday evening games, so we will need extra help from those that can work those games.

The Training/Certificates needed to work the games are not difficult but need to be taken care of before you're able to work with us. Food Handler and Alcohol Server cards are required as well as Levy specific training. You'll also need to submit a photo to for the NFL credentials. If you have worked with us at the stadium in the past please check your Class 12 Alcohol Server and Food Servers cards to make sure you're eligible to work the games.
